Our fixed price procedures are designed to help our referring vets be able to make a quick, hassle-free referral.

Unlike many referral centres, these prices include the management of any peri-operative complications.

They cover the period from daytime admission of the patient to the soft tissue service through to the initial discharge from hospital following surgery.
